


The Verbum Dei High School annual Mardi Gras Dinner is our celebration of scholarship support for our students. It costs Verbum Dei about \$14,000 to educate each student per year, while the tuition is only \$2,700. (However, families actually pay an average of about \$1,100 as no student is turned away for lack of funds.) The Corporate Work Study Program generates about \$7,000 per student per year which goes directly to the cost of education. This leaves \$4,100 to \$5,900 each year which must come from fundraising efforts by the school. With the hope of enrolling 300 students each year, the gap is quite significant.
